

SUMMER SCHOOL REPORT - 2022

Flixton Girls School ran a successful summer school during August as an extension to our transition programme this year. In collaboration with our feeder primary schools we identified the potential benefit of giving our future students the opportunity to familiarise themselves with the school building, meet some of their future teachers in a more relaxed environment as well as mixing with some of the other new pupils.

The summer school was a mixture of enriching activities such as Art, Poetry and Martial Arts together with some of the more academic skills such as Numeracy and Science. The theme of the programme was celebrating other cultures, in particular those relating to the continent of Africa.

Some of the key themes we developed over the two weeks were:

- Building confidence.
- Develop presentation and performance skills.
- Encourage logical thought and problem-solving processes.
